John Muir Elementary School Gate Replacement

Project Overview

A new pedestrian gate was installed to allow school staff to control access to the campus from the main office. The new system includes:

- Two-way voice communication
- Keypad to access the school
- Video camera that enables staff to recognize visitors at the gate (the system has no archival capability and the cameras are strictly used for recognition and access).
