We will be accepting delivery of portable buildings for our modernization project and the parking lot must be clear to accomplish the delivery and installation.
All cars must be moved by 1 pm, or your car may be towed.

The MHS modernization project continues with the first set of relocatable classrooms arriving to Malibu High School this week. Relocatable buildings P5-P9 will be delivered and placed on the upper blacktop at MHS.

Friday, October 28:

- The Fire Lane and Student Parking Lot will not be accessible after 3 pm
- All vehicles must be out of the student parking lot by 1:30 pm (remaining vehicles may be towed)
- Drop Off and Pick ups for events will need to be in the front of the school
- This includes: Water Polo Game, School Dance, Coffee House, Boys & Girls Club, City Programs

Saturday, October 29:

The Fire Lane and Student Parking Lot will not be accessible from 5 am until installation is completed.

There will be additional Campus Security Officers supporting the safety of the students and movement of vehicles.
