Important Info for Parents, Students and Staff

There will be no student drop-off in the morning on Friday, Nov. 4th on the driveway or upper student parking lot. The upper student parking lot will be closed.

If students can be picked up and dropped off, that is best, however, students with a valid student parking permit will be allowed to park in the two-tier staff parking lot at the front of the school near the curve on Morning View Dr. The driveway, upper lot and blacktop area will all be available for after school use including the football game.

The MHS / JCES modernization project continues with the second set of relocatable classrooms arriving to JCES on Friday, November 4th at 9 am. Relocatable buildings P1-P5 will be installed adjacent to the Boys & Girls Club relocatable building on the blacktop.

Friday, November 4:

- The MHS staff will park on the upper playground, where the basketball courts are located.
- The Fire Lane and Student Parking Lot will not be accessible between 9 am and 3 pm.
- Student Parking Lot A will be available after 3 pm for after-school events on Friday.
- There will be additional Campus Security Officers supporting the safety of the students and movement of vehicles.
