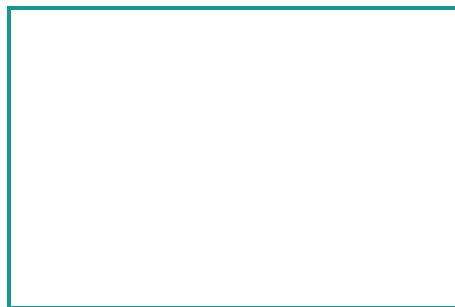
Important Info for Parents, Students and Staff

All students in the middle school building and bungalows 511-513 will be moving into their new classrooms in the recently installed new relocatable buildings at MHS and the modernized JCES Building F upon return from winter break!

Parking, drop-off/pick-up will not be altered at this time.

Dec. 13, 2016

- The MHS / JCES modernization project continues with all Malibu High School students currently in the middle school building (Building E) moving to the new temporary buildings or the modernized Building F at JCES upon return from winter break.
- Current teachers will announce the assigned classroom to students before break.
- The MHS Library, College Career Center, Community Service Learning Office and the Psychologist Office will also be moved into a relocatable building during winter break.
- Site utility infrastructure is just about complete, with some closures of the driveway and fire lane still expected. Please use caution through this area.
- The relocatable buildings are brand new and utilize the latest in materials with attention to sustainability, while providing a comfortable environment for our students and staff.
- Building F at JCES has been renovated with all new windows, doors, paint and floors. Post-renovation sampling for PCBs in the modernized Building F has confirmed that no PCBs are present above the EPA remediation goal.
- All of JCES planned modernization is now complete throughout the school.
